The annual All Starz Dance Recital is scheduled to be held on Saturday, April 17 outdoors at Metcalf Park, 315 W. Beale St., in Kingman, AZ. All Starz Academy Of Gymnastics & Dance LLC strives to provide family friendly events within the community, all while being safe and COVID-19 conscious. Provided is our COVID-19 Mitigation Plan for the "Weathering The Storm" All Starz Recital 2021.

1. Cleaning and Disinfecting:

- 1. A set cleaning schedule will be maintained for frequently touched surfaces such as doors, handrails, & sink handles. Chlorox bleach wipes will be used.
- 2. Shared objects, such as registration terminals will be disinfected between uses.
- 3. Proper use of personal protection will be followed when cleaning. Such as use of gloves, proper disposal of gloves, post cleaning hand washing, and use of face coverings.

2. Restrooms:

- 1. We will ensure park restroom facilities are open/available and that the toilets and sinks function properly.
- 2. Maintain a schedule for restroom cleaning and stocking to ensure that ample hand soap/sanitizer and paper products are available at all times.

3. Hand-washing and Sanitation:

- 1. Handwashing stations will be available in the park restrooms.
- 2. Hand sanitation stations will be dispersed throughout the event.

4. Water Systems/Supply:

- 1. Our event will have a safe water supply for drinking and cleaning.
- 2. Staff and participants will be encouraged to bring their own water bottles if possible.
- 3. We will clean and sanitize common access drinking water supply stations routinely.

5. Food Services:

- 1. Vendor based food services (Rickety Cricket) will follow the current policies outlined by the Mohave County Health Department.
- 2. Cleaning and disinfecting schedules for frequently touched surfaces will be followed.
- 3. Touchless payment will be used whenever possible and applicable. If cash transactions occur, hand to hand contact will be avoided.
- 4. Use of disposable food service items (dishes/utensils) will be followed. All non-disposable items are handled w/ gloves & sanitized. There will be no self-serve option for food/beverage disbursement.

6. Audience:

- 1. Masks will be recommended.
- 2. Social distancing of maintaining a 6 ft. distancing will be encouraged.

7. Signage:

- 1. Signs will be posted reminding attendees to wash or sanitize their hands. Masks will be recommended & social distancing encouraged.
- 2. Signage will be placed around the event that explain the symptoms of COVID-19 and how to report if you have symptoms.

8. Physical Guides:

1. We will stay up to date on any regulations on group gatherings.

- 2. Monitor CDC, State of Arizona and City of Kingman guidelines, mandates and procedures to determine the parameters in which this event can operate.
- 9. Protections for Staff, Volunteers, and Attendees:
 - 1. Staff, volunteers or attendees will be asked remain at home if they are sick or exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or if they have had a close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19.
 - 2. In person organizational meetings prior to the event and during the event will be limited to ensure that precautions are being taken to ensure safe interactions.

10. Participation Management:

- 1. Staff will be conducting a staggered check in, advance registration, & advance ticket sales.
- 2. Staff will be assigned to watch and ensure that proper protocols are being followed.
